ITEM 720 - REWEIGHS AND OVER-SIZED FREIGHT

1. At its sole discretion, 2 Day may reweigh shipments in its custody. Such reweighs will be conducted on scales owned by 2 Day, including platform scales or lift truck scales with a manufacturer's specified tolerance of plus or minus 1%. The accuracy of such scales will be regularly verified by an independent company.

If an error in weight is determined, 2 Day will correct the billed weight accordingly. Class rates will be adjusted accordingly. Pallet rates may be assessed overweight fees as appropriate.

2. Upon request by either the consignor, consignee, or the third party, the carrier will reweigh any shipment on carrier scales. A failure to enter a weight on the bill of lading will be considered to be a request to reweigh. Such reweigh will only be made while shipment is in the possession of 2 Day and no adjustments will be made after delivery has been made. A charge of \$30.00 per shipment will be assessed for this service.
3. Also at its sole discretion, 2 Day may measure the dimensions of pallets/pieces to ensure that they adhere to our limits. Should an oversized pallet/piece large than 48"x 48" x 84" be identified under our pallet rate program, the shipment will be rerated for the correct number of spots taken. If a skid is oversized by more than 3" in length or width, it will be billed as an extra spot.
4. On either pallet or class rate shipments all pieces at the following lengths will each be charged the applicable over-length handling fees:

Pieces between 55" and 95"	\$50.00 per piece
Pieces between 96" and 144"	\$135.00 per piece
Pieces between 145" and 191"	\$265.00 per piece
Pieces between 192" and 239"	\$400.00 per piece
Pieces between 240" and 335"	\$750.00 per piece
Pieces greater than 335"	\$1,000.00 per piece

5. All pallets that exceed 84" in height will be charged a \$20 overheight fee.
