ITEM 450 - BILLS OF LADING CORRECTED

Corrected bills of lading, or other written instructions requiring a change to the original bill of lading — including, but not limited to: (a) a change in the paying party; (b) a change in the billing address; (c) a change in collection status from "collect" to "prepaid" or from "prepaid" to "collect"; or (d) the addition, change, or deletion of a "third party billing" or "send freight bill to" party — may be permitted at the sole discretion of 2 Day, subject to the following conditions:

1. Changes in bill of lading or payor of freight charges

- a. The charge for any change to the collection status before delivery will be \$20.00.
- b. A change in collection status or paying party will not be allowed after payment has been received on the basis of the original bill of lading.
- c. 2 Day must receive a written request for a change in collection status or paying party within 30 days of the date of the initial bill of lading. The written request must include the name of the person requesting the change. Approval of any change is at the discretion of 2 Day.
- d. The original and new debtor must both have established credit with 2 Day.
- e. The party requesting the change in collection status or paying party must guarantee, in writing, immediate payment of the applicable freight charges (and any additional charges incurred by 2 Day) should the new debtor fail to pay within the credit period authorized under 49 CFR Part 377, Subpart B.
- f. Section 7 of the corrected bill of lading (the non-recourse/sight-draft provision) must not be executed.
- g. The party requesting the change shall hold 2 Day harmless and indemnify it against any liability arising out of the change.

2. Change in description or weight

Changes in description or weight will be permitted only upon presentation of satisfactory documentation (e.g., the original invoice and descriptive literature) acceptable to 2 Day showing that the original bill of lading was in error. Any such change is at the discretion of 2 Day. The charge shown in Paragraph 1(a) will apply.
