ITEM 710 - PROHIBITED ITEMS

1. Property of Extraordinary Value.

Unless otherwise provided, the following property will neither be accepted for shipment nor as premiums accompanying other articles:

- Bank bills
- Currency, other than coin
- Deeds
- Drafts
- Jewelry, other than costume or novelty jewelry
- Letters, with or without stamps affixed
- Museum exhibits or articles of antiquity
- Notes
- Original works of art
- Postage stamps
- Precious metals, bullion, or bullion coins, including gold, silver, platinum, and other precious metals or articles
- Precious stones
- Revenue stamps
- Valuable papers of any kind

2. Freight Liable to Damage Other Freight or Equipment. 2 Day is not obligated to receive freight liable to impregnate or otherwise damage other freight or 2 Day's equipment, including but not limited to carbon black.

3. Hazardous Materials of any kind.

4. Freight that is packaged in such a way as to create a safety concern.

5. Records or Data Containing Personal or Financial Information. This includes, but is not limited to, records or data in any form containing Social Security numbers, dates of birth, driver's license numbers, credit card numbers, or other financial account information.

6. Other items to include:

- Temperature controlled shipments
- Perishable food or goods
- Firearms, explosives, or ammunition
- Animals, livestock, or pets
- Live plants
- Automobiles
- Human remains or corpses
- Carbon black or similar material
- Tobacco, prescription drugs, or alcohol
- Garbage, refuse, or trash

7. If any of the commodities listed in this Item are inadvertently accepted, 2 Day will not be liable for any loss or damage to any such commodity. The Consignor, or its agent, agrees to defend, indemnify, and reimburse 2 Day for any physical harm, damage, or liability that may result in any way from the transportation of any prohibited commodity listed in this Item. If the foregoing indemnification is not applicable for any reason, then 2 Day shall be subject to a maximum liability of \$0.10 per pound per piece or a maximum of \$250.00 per occurrence in the event of loss or damage to any shipment.
